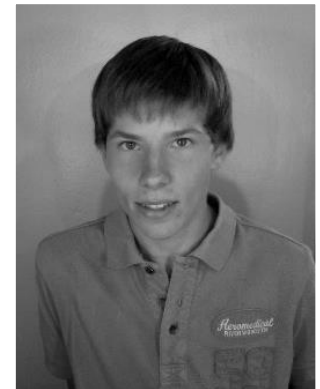

Doctoral journey



What we expect from you before 31 May

- ① Prepare your yearly progress report
 - short, but informative
 - template available
 - share it with your supervisor and PhD committee
- ② Organize a committee meeting in May at the latest
- ③ Prepare minutes of the meeting,
focusing on **helpful feedback for your research**
- ④ Upload the progress report and minutes
on myULiege, together with the **training activities**



Doctoral training

Thematic training: high-level disciplinary training, related to the topic of the PhD research

Transversal training: international research stays, public communications ...

Scientific production: scientific publications and communications that make up the doctoral journey
(think of a paper-based PhD ...)



THEMATIC DISCIPLINARY TRAINING (>15 credits)

2nd cycle courses, with evaluation (max. 10 credits)

3rd cycle courses, specialized courses, summer schools (1 credit / day)

Taking part in a departmental seminar
(1 credit / 5h cumulated)

Taking part in an international congress (2 credits)



GENERIC SKILLS TRAINING (>10 credits)

Training on scientific communication, proposal development, project management, IP ...

Scientific mission abroad (min. 2 weeks) ,
or in a company (min. 1 month)

Organization of a(n) (inter)national scientific event

Didactic support, supervision of a master thesis ...

Language courses, IFRES training ...



SCIENTIFIC PRODUCTION (>25 credits)

Peer-reviewed paper published in
an international journal, as a main author
(up to 12 credits, for a publication in a top journal)

Peer-reviewed paper published in
an international journal, as a co-author

Active participation to international conferences
(up to 5 credits, with an oral communication)
